



## Warranty

As a proud member of the Registered Master Joiners, we offer a 5 year warranty against defects in materials and workmanship.

This will take effect from date of delivery to site.

## Care and Maintenance

To ensure longevity and product guarantee, all joinery must be sealed and protected from weather with an oil based finish, either enamel paint or an oil/stain. This should be applied before installation or immediately after. The oil based enamel primer applied to our paint quality joinery does not protect against sun or moisture, but is primarily a key coat for oil based enamel undercoat and 2 x finish coats.

All doors and sashes must be completely coated all edges, faces, rebates and under all hardware or hinges. Paint must overlap the join, by 2mm, between putty/bead and glass, to ensure a proper seal.

We do not recommend finishing joinery in clear or dark tones, as this increases the likelihood of excessive timber movement, cracking, twisting and distortion due to heat from direct or indirect sunlight or artificial heat. No liability will be accepted for poor installation procedures and failure to protect from weather before a proper paint system is applied.

It is important to ensure all sliding/bifold systems and tracks are kept clean and free from debris to provide optimum performance. Regular routine maintenance for all timber joinery should include re-coating of paint or stain system when ageing or wear becomes apparent.
